



Dr. Marijana Mladenov is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Law for Commerce and Judiciary, University Business Academy in Novi Sad. She completed her basic studies at the Faculty of Law, University of Novi Sad, in 2009. At the same faculty, she defended the master thesis titled "The Right to Privacy in the Practice of the European Court of Human Rights" in 2010, and completed her doctoral studies in 2017, thesis "Right to an adequate environment as a fundamental human right". In October 2018, she was elected for Vice-Dean for International Cooperation at the Faculty of Law for Commerce followed by the election for the Director of International Relations Office at the University Business Academy in Novi Sad.
